Some of my favorite things:

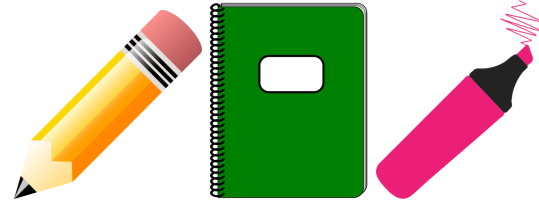

Homework and Extra Credit:

- When homework is assigned, students WILL have some time at the end of class to start on their homework and ask any questions.
- Bonus questions will be provided on MOST quizzes and tests for students to earn extra points. Extra credit can be awarded on projects if seen fit and the student provides more than the required material.
- Each student has the option to submit up to two article summaries per semester for up to 10 points extra credit each. These must be turned in no less than 5 days before the end of the quarter.

Grading:

- Tests and Projects: 40%
- In Class Work and Quizzes: 30%
- Homework: 25%
- Participation: 5%

Late Work/Absent Policy:

- If an assignment is not completed by class time, it is considered Late. Late work will be deducted 1 letter grade for every day late and the student will sit out at recess. Example: If an assignment is due Monday and “Tommy” doesn’t have it and turns it in on Tuesday, Tommy can only receive a 93%. If Tommy doesn’t turn in the work until Wednesday, Tommy can only receive an 85%. Day 3 past the due date, the student will receive a 0% and will still need to turn in the missing/late work.
- Absent students are responsible for making up any work they missed (allowed one day per day absent)

Rewards:

- Each student will be given a punch card and will be given punches based on above-average behavior, showing responsibility, and being a good classmate.
- Once their card has 10 punches, they can pull a prize stick and receive their reward.
