January- IL Constitution

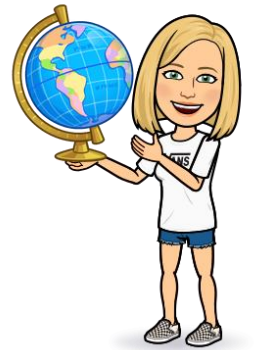
February- Roaring 20s & The Great Depression

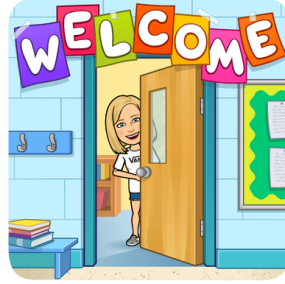


Study lists are available on Quizlet. DO NOT wait and study a few days before assessment. Review daily or weekly at least.

### INBs

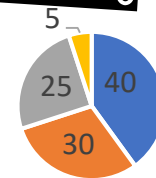
INBs are to be in a spiral based notebook for more room. Requirements:
